- Built a 50% disability-inclusive workforce, fostering true workplace diversity



Empowering Women and PwDs: Employability Program in Tirupur

We are excited to launch our Employability Training Program for Women and Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in Tirupur, in



partnership with one of our esteemed collaborators! This time, we **flipped the model**—instead of training first, we identified job requirements and then tailored our training accordingly

We kicked off on **February 14** with an orientation on career opportunities in the Banking, Financial Services, and Insurance (BFSI) sector. Participants will gain:

Industry-specific skills - BFSI sector essential Soft skills
training - Communication, teamwork, and leadership
Resume-building & interview preparation - Helping
candidates stand out

By equipping women in **Tier-3** cities with **tech-driven** skills, we empower them to **thrive**, **gain** respect, and **uplift** their families and society. We are excited for the impact ahead!

Inclusive Typing Training for Visually Impaired Trainers

At **WinVinaya**, we believe in the **power of collaboration**—empowering trainers creates a **ripple effect** that benefits countless students.

This month, we conducted a **train-the-trainer session** for **visually impaired trainers from Mithra Jyothi**, introducing them to the **Speed Typing Tool** to help visually impaired students improve **typing speed and accuracy—**a common challenge for many.

Key Highlights:

- ♦ Screen-reader-friendly Speed Typing Tool Accessibility at its core
- Hands-on Training Guided by both sighted and visually impaired trainers
- Progress Monitoring & Feedback Tracking student improvements
- ♦ **Q&A Session** Clarified doubts and prepared trainers to guide students effectively

Trainers found the session **extremely valuable**, boosting their confidence in guiding students. **A big step toward digital inclusion!**

Empowering MSMEs through Digital Marketing and Financial Literacy

- ♦ Online Marketing Insights Learning real-time strategies for digital success

A standout moment was seeing MSME owners, skilled in roti making and potato chips production, eagerly explore Canva and InShot to promote their businesses. Their excitement reinforced the practical impact of the training.

Beyond digital marketing, we also emphasized **financial literacy**, helping MSMEs manage their businesses **efficiently**. This initiative bridges the gap between **traditional and digital business strategies**, fostering **sustainable community growth**.

In our recent Chai with Changemakers sessions, we had inspiring conversations with Seena Ravindran (DEI Leader, Sutherland) and Vineet Saraiwala (Founder, Atypical Advantage) on driving sustainable change in diversity and inclusion.

Key takeaways -

- Small Actions, Big Impact: Inclusion starts with everyday moments—like a blind employee using Google Pay inspiring broader financial inclusion efforts.
- Breaking Biases: Unconscious biases around gender, disability, and LGBTQ+ inclusion must be challenged to create equitable workplaces.
- Beyond Hiring: True inclusion reflects in employee experience, leadership accountability, and a culture of belonging culture of belonging.
- Expanding Opportunities: Atypical Advantage connects PwDs beyond art and entertainment to corporate, manufacturing, and leadership roles—proving skills matter more than disabilities.

Powerful Moments:

- ♦ Seena was deeply inspired watching a employee with visually impairment at WinVinaya effortlessly use Power BI, shattering stereotypes about disability and technology.
- ♦ Vineet's mission began when he struggled to find a singer with a disability for a corporate event, leading him to create India's largest livelihood platform for PwDs.

Call to Action:

- Hire & Empower: Commit to hiring at least one PwD and provide post-placement support like job coaches and accessibility tools.
- ♦ Challenge Assumptions: See capabilities, not limitations—inclusion starts with shifting mindsets.
- ♦ Be the Catalyst: Take small but consistent actions—each step creates a ripple effect for lasting change.

What Makes MargaDarshan Unique?

At MargaDarshan 2025 (January), we saw firsthand how companies moved from curiosity to commitment in disability hiring. Some arrived to explore; they left as champions of inclusion.

Key Highlights from MargaDarshan 2025

We curated an immersive experience featuring:

Fireside Chat: Industry leaders, inclusive education institutes, an employee with a disability, and a parent of a special child shared candid insights on breaking barriers, implementing best practices, and fostering inclusive hiring.

Innovation & Accessibility Showcase: We introduced stalls featuring innovative platforms and assistive devices designed for candidates with disabilities and companies seeking to provide reasonable accommodations.

Experiential Zone: A **fun, interactive space** where inclusive companies, volunteers, and first-time explorers:

- ♦ Learned **15 sign language phrases in just 15 minutes**, proving ISL is simple and fun.
- Stepped into the world of sensory navigation by experiencing blindfolded chess and screen-reader demos, gaining firsthand empathy for visual impairment.
- ◆ Connected with "Our Baggage"—a unique neurodiverse experience, highlighting the strengths and perspectives of individuals from the neurodiverse community.

Notably, this entire experiential zone was designed and managed by persons with disabilities!

Breaking Barriers: Empowering Neurodiverse Talent for Inclusive Education

At WinVinaya, we believe **education should be a choice**, **not a privilege limited by accessibility**. To bridge this gap, we piloted an **on-the-job training program**, where **neurodiverse candidates** worked on **document remediation**, making **Math**, **Physics**, **and Chemistry** books accessible for individuals with visual impairments.

A dedicated team of six neurodiverse individuals, led by Arun, a visually impaired colleague, worked alongside Deaf colleagues and persons without disabilities to transform Word documents into EPUB format. Through a structured 15-step process, they mastered alignment, numbering, table creation, inserting equations, and image snipping to create inclusive learning materials.

To ensure their success, we built a **strong mentorship and support system**:

- Buddies and mentors for hands-on guidance and collaboration
- ♦ A job coach to foster teamwork and problemsolving
- ♦ Workplace etiquette training, covering professionalism and communication
- ♦ Daily progress tracking to instill accountability

The outcome? **Remarkable growth!** These individuals showcased **punctuality, focus, and determination**, earning immense pride from their families.

Inclusive companies, let's break barriers together! This pilot proves that with the right support, neurodiverse individuals can excel in the workforce.
