MargaDarshan 2025: A Beacon of Inclusivity and Innovation



At WinVinaya Foundation, our mission has always been to foster an inclusive society where talent is recognized beyond the confines of ability or disability. MargaDarshan 2025 was not just an

event; it was a testament to this mission, showcasing the power of diversity, technology, and collective effort.

A Transformational Journey

Before stepping into this sector, many of us held preconceived notions about the capabilities of Persons with Disabilities (PwDs). We often associated talent with conventional definitions of ability. However, working alongside a team rich in diverse abilities completely transformed our perspective. We witnessed firsthand that determination, skill, and opportunity define talent—not physical or cognitive abilities.

Unified Preparation: The Teams Behind Success

The success of MargaDarshan 2025 was driven by the dedication of multiple teams working seamlessly together:

Infrastructure & Logistics: Ensured an accessible and welcoming environment for all. A team led by colleagues with disabilities worked alongside those without disabilities, breaking barriers and inspiring leadership.

Placement: Engaged with 280 companies through continuous follow-ups, sensitizing leaders, and mapping candidates. On the day of the event, 11 companies participated, with 7 more showing commitment to disability hiring.

Candidate Council: Trainers, coordinators, volunteers, and interns connected candidates with suitable roles and provided interview training to ensure they were fully prepared.

Event Coordination: Created a crisp and engaging agenda, blending music, dance, fireside chats, and presentations for an impactful experience.

Marketing: A diverse team ensured the event's message reached the right audience before, during, and after, amplifying our impact through social media.

Beyond a Job Fair: A Celebration of Talent

MargaDarshan 2025 went beyond the traditional job fair model. It was a celebration of talent and diversity, with inclusivity at its core. From accessible registration counters



to cultural performances by PwD artists, every element was designed to empower and inspire.

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Highlights of the Day

Inauguration: The event commenced with a lamp-lighting ceremony, followed by a soulful prayer song by an individual with an intellectual disability, setting an inspiring tone.

Introduction to WinVinaya: Mr. Shiva Jayagopal, Founder Chairman, shared the organization's journey, addressing the pressing social issue we are solving today.

CSR Impact Dashboard: Mrs. Neeraja demonstrated an innovative Power BI dashboard, showcasing how data can be used for transparency, tracking progress, and storytelling.

ISL Sprint: HSI trainers taught 15 phrases in 15 minutes, proving sign language is easy to learn.

Sensory Safari: Visually impaired individuals guided participants through a blindfolded chess game, raising awareness of non-visual navigation.

Neuro Embrace: Showcased talents in document remediation, Zoho bookkeeping, and more.

Empowering Opportunities: Making an Impact

The core of MargaDarshan 2025 lay in creating meaningful career opportunities:

30+ job roles in MIS, Accounting, Data Analysis, Software Testing, and more.

76 candidates participated in rigorous interviews and networking.

126 interviews were conducted, paving the way for career breakthroughs.

Accessible Communication: ISL interpreters and real-time captions ensured inclusivity for all attendees.

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
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Reflections and Moving Forward
