




#### WinVinaya Utsav!

#### Placements!



She is a person who is confident and determined not to let her disability stop her from achieving her goals. From getting admitted into school to getting a job she has always strived to be her best and pushed her boundaries. She has come across a lot of challenges along her way including not being able get admission for her schooling or participate in extra-curricular activities in college because of her disability. But she proved them wrong. She won a gold medal in her under graduation for excellence, she also took part in the Paralympic games conducted by her college, played chess and won a bronze medal for the same. She had won the 2nd rank in national level for the Brain Hunt event organized by Dainik Bhaskar. (Daily Newspaper - Hindi) and many other competitions in school and college.

Priyanka is very talented. She said the lockdown gave her a lot of time to work on what she loves such as singing, writing poetry, and short stories. She also made use of this time to gain industry ready skills and knowledge from various online courses and from her internship at V-Beyond.

She believes that being dedicated, hardworking and her eagerness to learn new things are her strengths and that her family is her biggest support and motivation. She said that the training at WinVinaya enhanced her communication skills and confidence to speak up, which helped her in a great way to attend interviews and clear them.

She dreams of becoming an entrepreneur someday. Once she becomes successful she wants to contribute towards educating other persons with disabilities by starting a school for the persons with disabilities and aims to provide cost-free education to them.
