

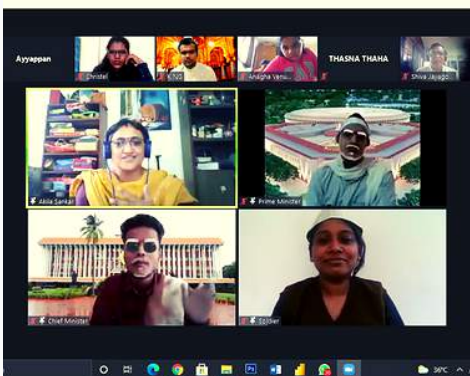

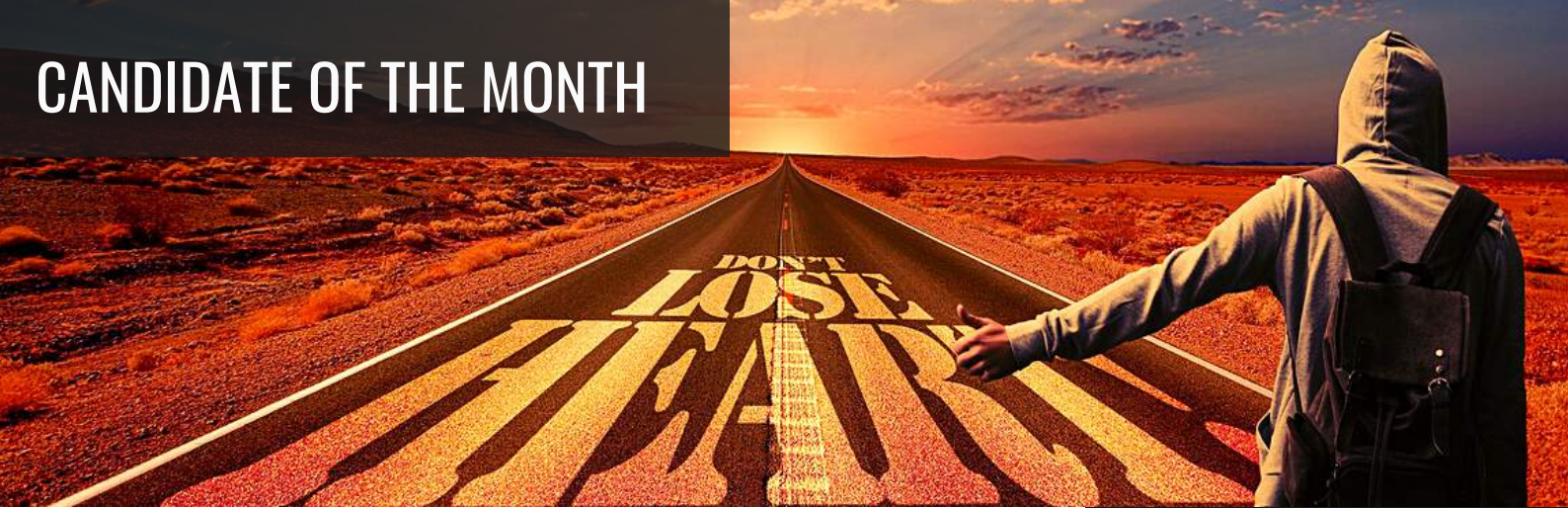
Volunteering
