Recently few of WinVinaya's employees moved on due to various reasons (bigger company, better salary, greater opportunity, different role). They worked with us for 3+ years.

Anusha, Veeresh, and Vaishnavi who are persons with diverse disabilities joined WinVinaya as trainees. Looking at their sincerity, dedication and their interest, we took them into WinVinaya as employees. They were very raw, shy, timid but very sincere, determined, and ready to learn, unlearn and relearn things. They played many roles in WinVinaya - as software testers, web developers, content creators, and trainers to other PwD candidates. They learned new skills including Java, Power BI, and more.

All of them added great value to WinVinaya and continue to maintain a good relationship with us.

If we search in google on why people quit, the key reasons seem to be bad managers, feeling underappreciated or overworked and so on. But when our employees announced their decision to move on, we observed gratitude and confidence. Some had tears too.

One person said this as the reason for moving on - "I have learned a lot from WinVinaya and gained more confidence in myself. Now I want to move on, spread my knowledge and awareness of WinVinaya to others too."
